Getting What You Did Not Pray For

It goes without saying that the wisdom of God is greater than that of humanity. Despite that truth, most of the time I pray for outcomes that are often about me and my preferences - and probably not as tied into Divine Wisdom as I might think.

When things don't transpire the way we hope, we are have two basic choices. One is to complain, resist and remain frustrated. The other is to look with fresh eyes on the circumstance and ask if there might not be something beneficial in the situation. Moreover could it be that the bad news in my disappointments somehow help the Good News of God coming into being?


